- Rules of the Road
- Day Shapes, Vessel Lights, Sound Signals (in good visibility & fog)
- Buoyage
- Navigation
- Chartwork - Read latitude & longitude, plot bearings on the chart, measure distance
- Plot a 3-point-fix
- Calculate Course-to-Steer
